

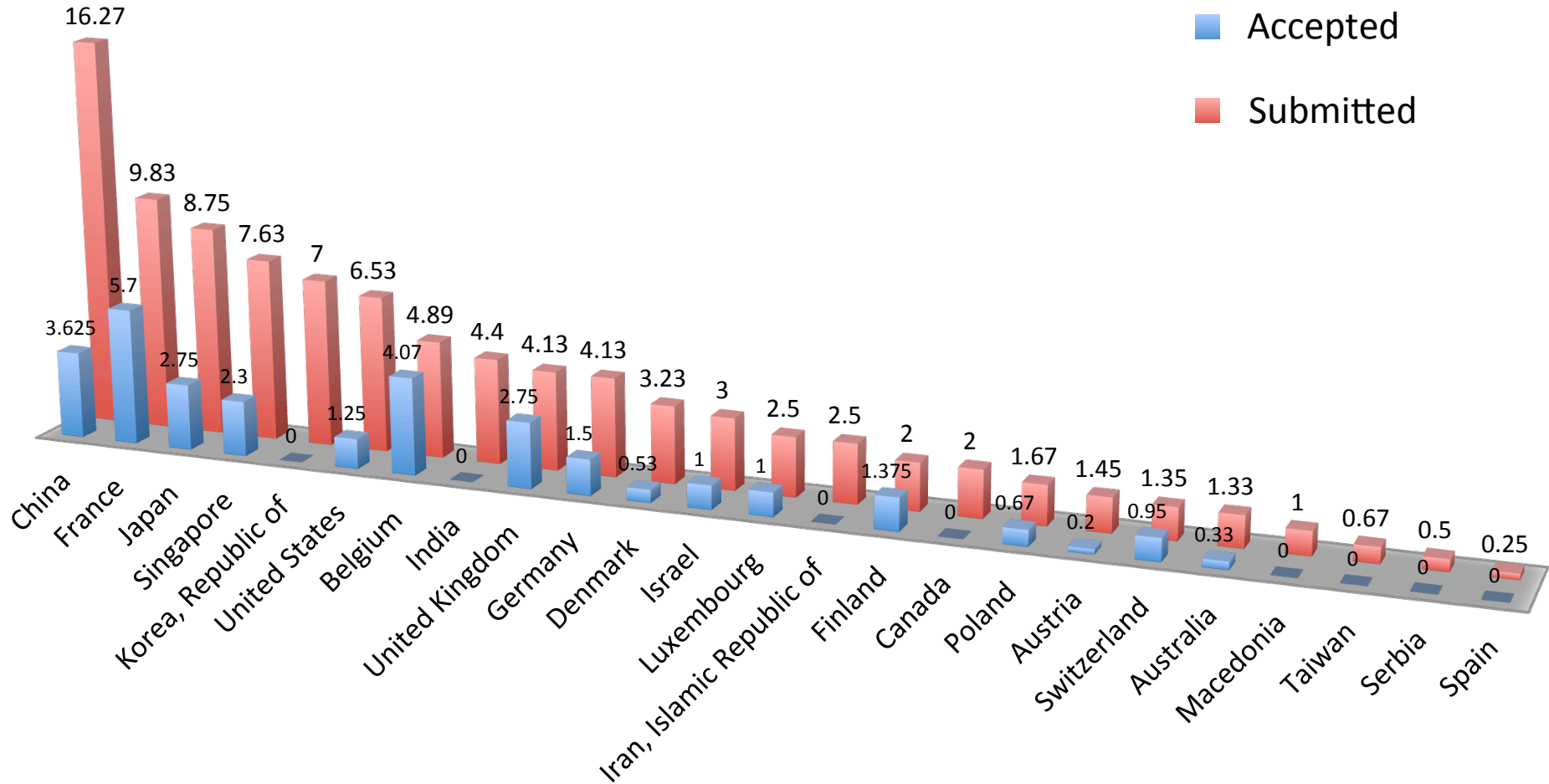

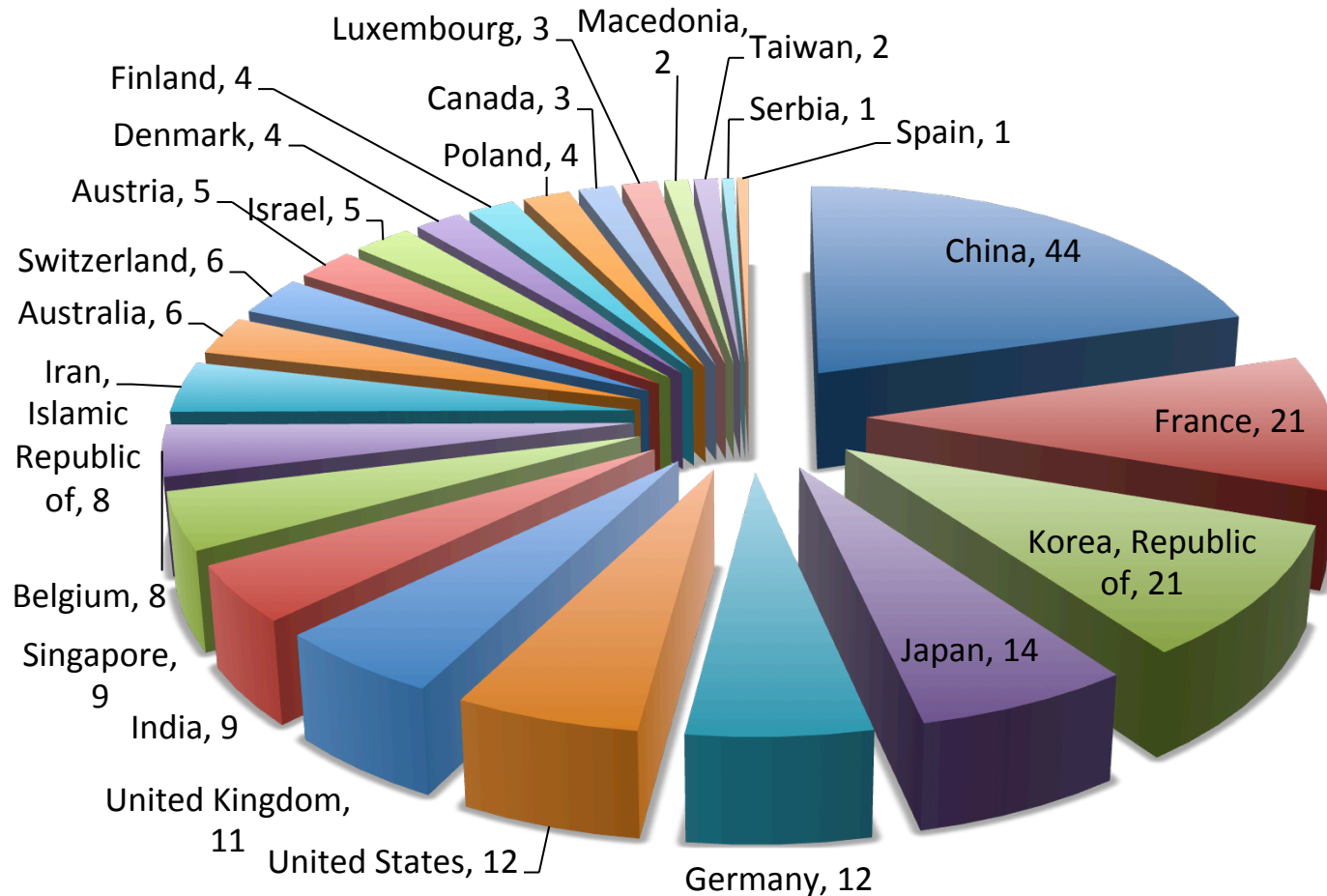

Statistics by Country

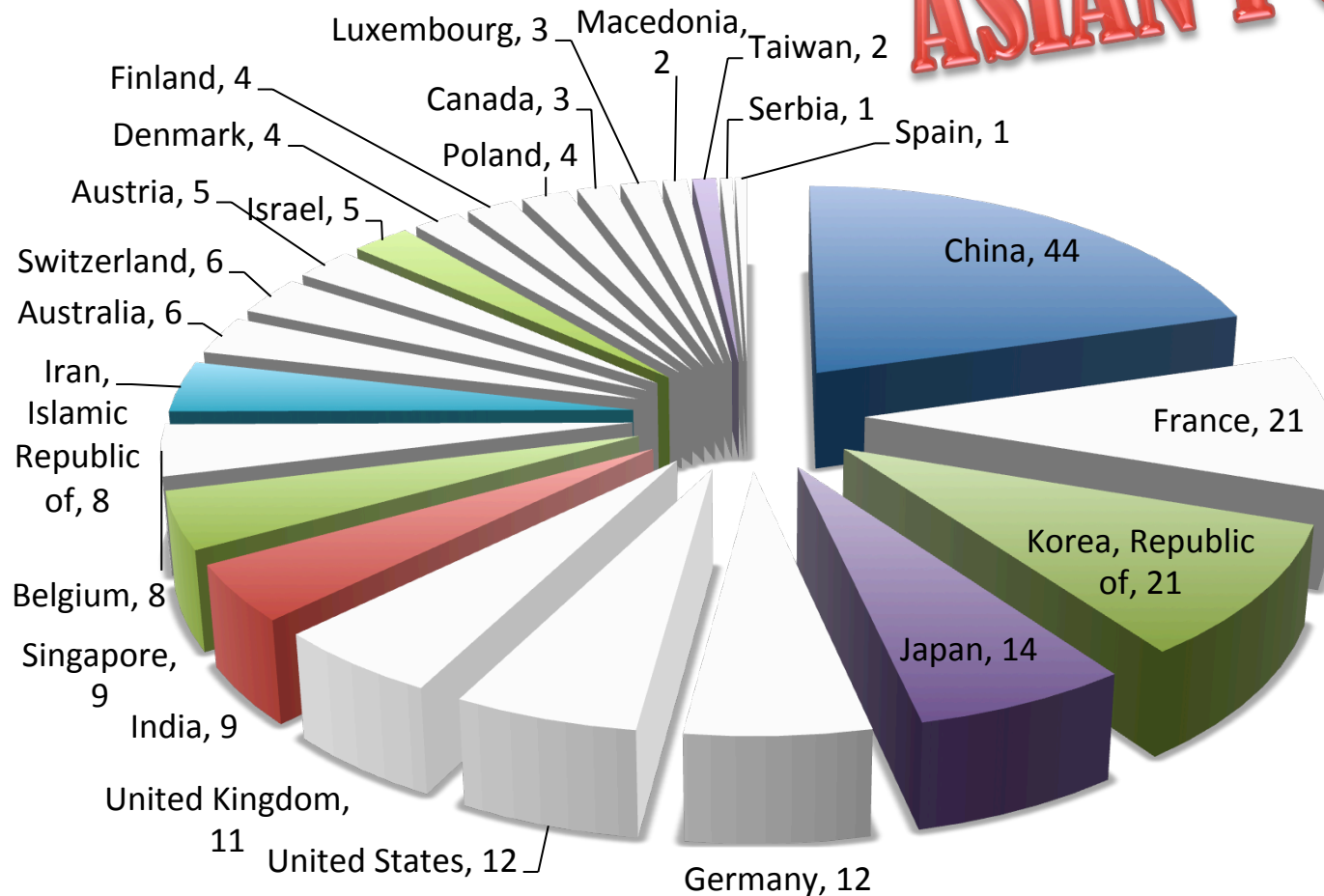
#Authors in Submitted Papers



Statistics by Country

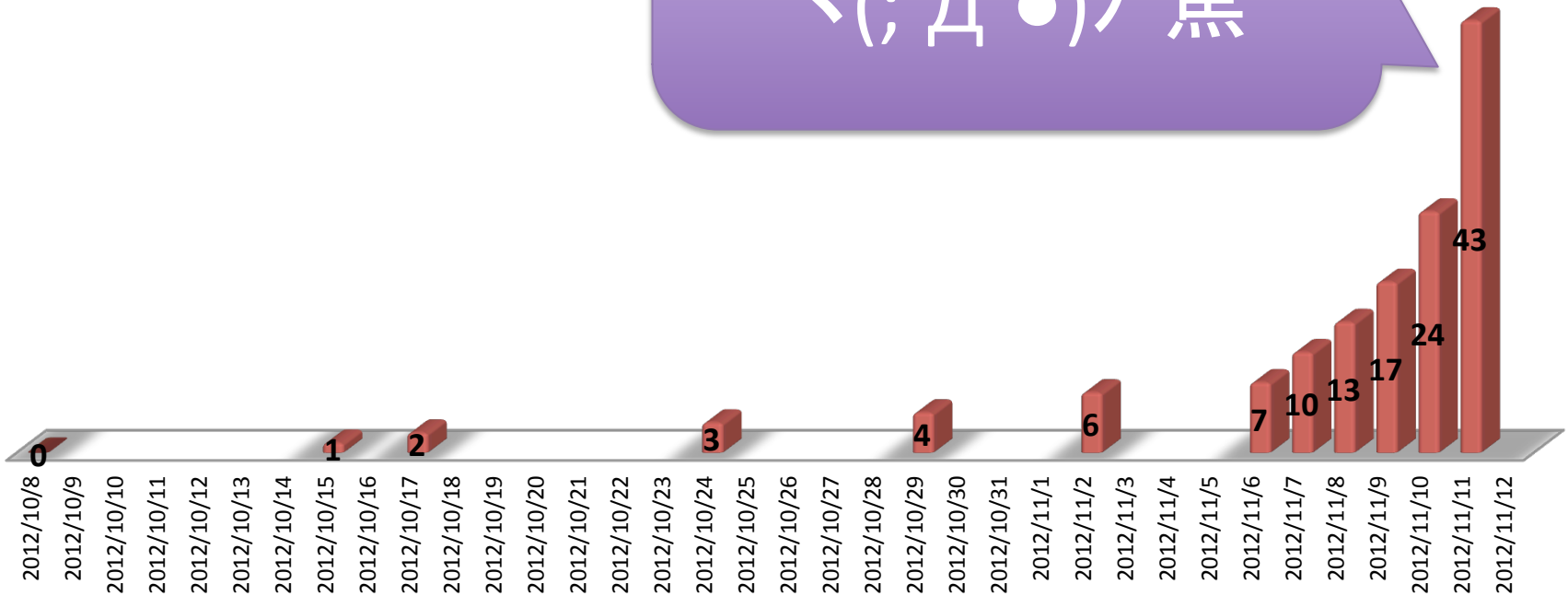
